RUSSIA'S STAR STUDDERED "ICE SHOW"
SKATES INTO BOARDWALK HALL SATURDAY MAY 31

TICKETS ARE ON SALE NOW

ATLANTIC CITY, NJ – "Ice Show", a fantastically popular Russian TV series, will skate into Boardwalk Hall's arena, Saturday, May 31 at 8:00 pm. Tickets are priced at \$250, \$200, \$150, \$125, \$100, \$75, and \$50.

The concept can only be described as deliciously daring. Russia's top pop stars are given a crash course in skating prior to the show. They are then paired with a dazzling cast of world-class figure skaters. Two teams emerge to compete on the show, headed by renowned figure skating coaches, Ilya Averbukh and Alexander Zhulin. "Ice Show" was developed by Russia's premier television channel, Channel One, and launched in September 2007. In that short time, "Ice Show" has garnered an incredible following, with the live version touring extensively throughout Russia, Europe and Asia.

Among the participants of "Ice Show" are 2002 Olympic Gold Singles Champion Aleksey Yagudin, 2006 Olympic Ice Dancing Champions Tatiana Navka & Roman Kostomarov, 2006 Olympic Pairs Champions Tatiana Totmianina and Maxim Marinin, 1998 Olympic Pairs Silver Medalist Anton Sikharulidze, European Champions Aleksey Tikhonov and Maria Petrova, 2002 Olympic Pairs Ice Dancing Silver Medalist Irina Lobacheva, Bulgarian ice dancer Albena Denkova, 2000 World Bronze Medalists Margarita Drobiazko & Povilas Vanagas, 1999 & 2000 World Professional Pairs Champions Elena Leonova & Andrei Khvalko, Israeli ice dancer Sergei Sakhnovsky, and Russian skater Anna Semenovich. Russian celebrities on tour include actresses Viktoriya Dayneko, Chulpan Khamatova, Olga Kabo, Alisa Grebenshikova, actors Alexander Dyachenko, Mikhail Galustyan, Igor Vernik, Aleksei Makarov, Dmitriy Maryanov, Grigory Sijatvinda, and Ville Haapasalo, tennis player Anastasia Myskina, Russian ballerina Anastasia Volochkova, performer Nikita Malinin, Larisa Verbitskaja, and Alexandra Savelyeva.
